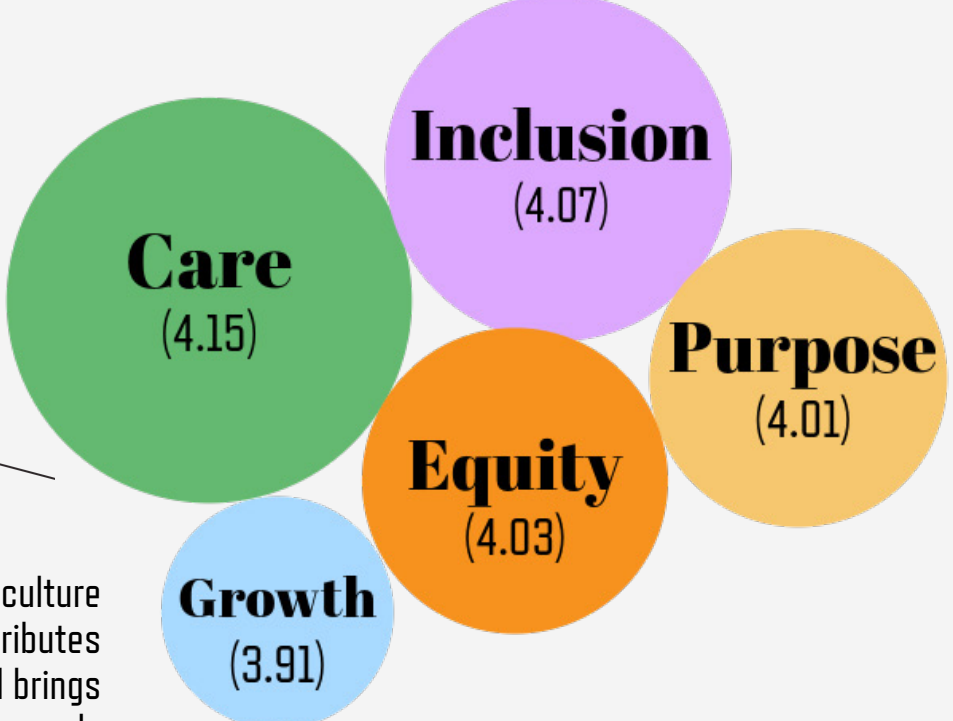

These anchors drive a workplace culture where everyone feels valued, contributes meaningfully, shares feedback, and brings their whole selves and fresh ideas to work.



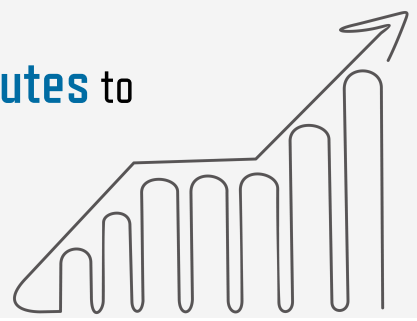
Retention
